Ambush Attacks Against Law Enforcement Officers



Deadly Calls and Fatal Encounters

In 2015, the [National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund \(NLEOMF\)](#) entered into a cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice COPS Office to study officer line-of-duty deaths. This report is a five-year study analyzing line-of-duty deaths in which a total of 684 cases were reviewed. Specifically, the analysis focused on cases involving dispatched calls for service that required a police response and the information that was made available to responding officers in the deadliest calls for service. Armed with this information, researchers were then tasked with determining whether any commonalities existed that could be utilized as learning tools to prevent future deadly calls or fatal encounters.

[2017 Mid-Year Law Enforcement Officer Fatalities Report](#)

According to preliminary data compiled by the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund, as of June 30, 2017, 65 federal, state, and local law enforcement officers have died in the line of duty this year, increasing 30 percent over the 50 officers killed during the same period last year.

[Fentanyl: A Brief Guide for First Responders](#)

There is a significant threat to law enforcement personnel, and other first responders, who may come in contact with fentanyl and other fentanyl-related substances through routine law enforcement, emergency or life-saving activities. Since fentanyl can be ingested orally, inhaled through the nose or mouth, or absorbed through the skin or eyes, any substance suspected to contain fentanyl should be treated with extreme caution as exposure to a small amount can lead to significant health-related complications, respiratory depression, or death.

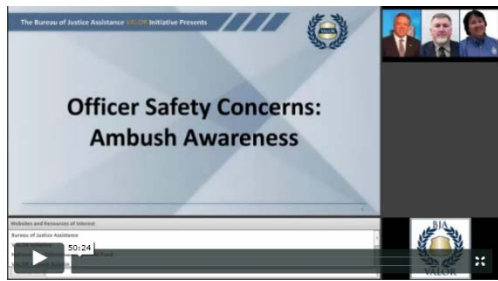
