On May 9, 2017, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Statistics released a report on police vehicle pursuits. In 2012, general-purpose state and local law enforcement agencies conducted an estimated 68,000 vehicle pursuits.
